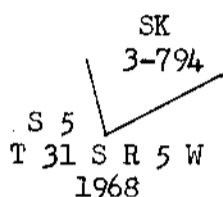
## CHAINS

Ascend 80 ft. over E. slope.

15.00 Spur, slopes N. 10° E.; desc. 100 ft. over NW. slope.

22.73 Cor. No. 3 Skookum Lode, restored by the method of broken boundaries, there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

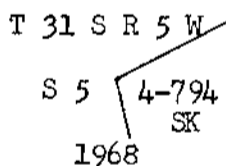
N 25° 55' W., on claim line 3-4, beginning new measurement.
