Dependent Resurvey, Portion Subdivisional Lines, T. 22 S., R. 7 W.

## CHAINS

14.70 Ridge, bears N. 60° W. and S. 60° E.; desc. 65 ft. over SW. slope.  
 21.40 Leave timber, enter pasture land, edge bears N. 60° W. and S. 60° E.  
 25.81 Intersect the E. bdy. of Donation Land Claim No. 43.  
 Point for the closing cor. of sec. 7 and 18.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, to top, with brass cap marked

from which

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N. 25° E., 234 lks. dist.,  
 mkd. T22S R7W S7 CC BT.

A fir, 13 ins. diam., bears S. 89½° E., 447 lks. dist.,  
 mkd. T22S R7W S18 CC BT.

Set a 6 ft. steel fence post alongside the iron post.

From this point the interior cor. on the E. bdy. of Claim 43, bears S. 0° 15' W., 3.62 chs. dist., hereinafter described.

Descend 30 ft. over SW slope.

40.14 Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 7 and 18, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, to top, with brass cap marked

 mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S7 BT.

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S. 34° W., 508 lks. dist.,  
 mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S18 BT.

Set a 6 ft. steel fence post alongside the iron post.

Descend 120 ft. over SW. slope.

57.45 Intersect the W. bdy. of Donation Land Claim No. 43.

Point for the closing cor. of secs. 7 and 18.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

 mkd, T22S R7W S7 CC BT.
