Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

26.30 Ravine, drains N. 10° W.; asc. 225 ft. over E. slope.

35.60 Spur ridge, bears N. 10° W. and S. 10° E.; desc. 130 ft. over W. slope.

39.65 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 28 and 33, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

42.05 Dirt road, 10 lks. wide, bears N. 15° W. and S. 15° E.

44.50 Ravine, drains N. 15° W.; asc. 315 ft. over NE. slope.

56.70 Spur, slopes N. 35° E.; desc. 375 ft. over NW. slope.

79.30 The cor. of secs. 28, 29, 32, and 33.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, clay loam.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, alder, and yew; undergrowth, hazel, Oregon grape, fern, and salal.
