CHAINS

The land is chiefly valuable for the timber resource and recreation. The timber stands are primarily fir, hemlock, cedar, oak, maple, yew, and chinquapin being noted. The undergrowth is generally Oregon grape, hazel, fir, salal, and poison oak.

There were several permanent residents noted in the northeastern portion of the section. Some Government and private lands have been logged in the area. There were no mineral deposits noted in the area.

The average of a number of observations made gives a value of  $19^{\circ} 15'$  E., for the mean magnetic declination. There is no difference due to local attraction.
