with healed blaze.

- 2.30 Ravine, drains E.; asc. 25 ft. over SE. slope.
- 3.45 Spur, slopes E.; desc. 85 ft. over NE. slope.
- 5.63 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course E.; asc. 70 ft. over SE. slope.
- 10.45 Spur, slopes E.; desc. 60 ft. over NE. slope.
- 14.00 Ravine, drains E.; asc. 20 ft. over SE. slope.
- 15.40 Spur, slopes E.; desc. 345 ft. over NE. slope, changing to
N. slope.
- 26.25 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course E.; asc. 350 ft. over SE. slope.
- 27.36 Dirt road, 10 lks. wide, bears E. and W.
- 38.70 Spur, slopes E.; also cor. of logged area, edges bear S. and W.;
desc. slightly along E. slope, through moderate timber and
dense undergrowth.
- 39.90 The cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, monumented with the original
quartz stone, 16 x 12 x 12 ins., firmly set, projecting 4 ins.
above the ground, mkd. with 1 groove on N., and 5 grooves on
S. face, alongside of which is an iron pipe, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly
set, projecting 16 ins. above ground, perpetuated and recorded
by the Douglas County Surveyor, in 1963, with brass cap mkd.

with scribe marks T30S R3W S12 BT visible on opened
blaze.
- A root hole, bears N. $67\frac{1}{2}^\circ$ W., $19\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist., with
a down fir alongside, 39 ins. diam., with healed
blaze.
