

Dependent Resurvey, Portion of Subdivisional Lines, T. 23 S., R. 9 W.

CHAINS

Land, mountainous.
Soil, rocky clay loam.
Timber, fir, hemlock, alder, maple, chinquapin, cedar, and myrtle;
undergrowth, hazel, rhododendron, salal, Oregon Grape, salmonberry,
arrowwood and fern.

S. 89° 54' W., bet. secs. 7 and 18.

Descend 210 ft. over general W. slope, through scattering timber
and dense undergrowth.

- 2.35 Dirt road, 30 lks. wide, bears N. and S.
- 12.50 Ravine, drains N.; asc. 265 ft. over broken NE. slope.
- 30.75 Spur ridge, bears N. 5° E. and S. 5° W.; desc. 150 ft. over W.
slope.
- 35.55 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course N. 20° W.; asc. 85 ft. over NE. slope.
- 39.73 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 7 and 18, at proportionate
distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in ground,
with brass cap mkd.

A hemlock, 11 ind. diam., bears N. 51° W., 28 $\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist.,
mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S7 BT.

A hemlock, 15 ins. diam., bears S. 15° E., 37 lks. dist.,
mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S18 BT.

Ascend 10 ft. over NE. slope.

- 40.60 Spur slopes N. 50° W.; desc. 195 ft. over S. slope.
- 45.75 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course NW.; asc. 260 ft. over NE. slope.
- 63.35 Dirt road, 25 lks. wide, in curve, bears N. 20° W. and SW.
- 65.55 Dirt road, 25 lks. wide, bears N. 40° W.; and S. 55° E.
- 72.70 Spur, slopes N.; desc. 170 ft. over W. slope.
- 79.66 The cor. of secs. 7, 12, 13, and 18, on the W. bdy. of the Tp.,
monumented with an iron post, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., firmly set, projecting
6 ins. above ground, with brass cap marked and witnessed as
described in the official record of the 1967 dependent resurvey.
