from which the original bearing tree

A fir, 25 ins. diam., bears N. 38° E., 33 lks. dist., with fragmentary scribe marks visible on rotted blaze; remarked by the County Surveyor in 1969, on new blaze T27S R1W S2 CS BT.

A fir, 27 ins. diam., bears S. 61° E., 32 lks. dist., with scribe marks 2 R1 BT visible on rotted blaze; remarked by the County Surveyor in 1969, on new blaze T27S R1W S11 CS BT.

A rotted fir stump, size indeterminate, bears S. 69° W., 28 lks. dist., no marks visible.

A fir, 30 ins. diam., bears N. 54° W., 52 lks. dist., with healed blaze; remarked by the County Surveyor in 1969, on new blaze T27S R1W S3 CS BT. (Record, 54 lks.)

and bearing tree marked by the County Surveyor

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 37½° W., 10 lks dist., with scribe marks T27S R1W S10 CS BT visible on open blaze.

The original corner stone found lying loose on top of ground, therefore, buried it alongside the iron pipe.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, loam.

Timber, fir, hemlock and pine; undergrowth, willow, Oregon grape, and rhododendron.

N. 0° 30' W., bet. secs. 2 and 3.

Descend 55 ft. over gentle N. slope, through heavy timber and light undergrowth.

6.75 Lookout Mountain Road, gravelled, 30 lks. wide, bears N. 74° W. and S. 74° E.

8.80 Emile Creek, 8 lks. wide, course N. 80° W.; asc. 10 ft. over broken SW. slope.

20.80 Leave timber, enter marsh, edge bears N. 35° E. and S. 35° W.

28.45 Dirt road, 10 lks. wide, bears N. 80° W. and S. 80° E., also edge of marsh, bears N. 30° E. and S. 30° W.; asc. 30 ft. over gentle SE. slope, through clear cut and burned area.

39.93 The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 2 and 3, monumented with the original basalt stone, 15 x 10 x 5 ins., firmly set, protruding 5 ins. above the ground, mkd. ¼ on W. face.

from which the remaining original bearing tree

A badly burned hemlock stump, size indeterminate, bears N. 60° E., 47 lks. dist., no marks visible. (Record, N. 62° E.)
