sea level on the ridge between sections 31 and 36.

The soil is composed generally of rocky and sandy loam. Timber is primarily fir, pine, cedar, with stands of oak, alder, yew, madrone, chinquapin, and maple; the undergrowth includes mansanita, hazel brush, and arrow wood.

No evidence of minerals was noted in the area resurveyed.

The average of a considerable number of observations made throughout the area gives a mean magnetic declination of 20° E., with a range of up to  $\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  in local attraction.
