

Dependent Resurvey, Portion of Subdivisional Lines, T. 23 S., R. 10 W.

CHAINS

33.90 Leave Ash Valley, enter logged area, edge bears N. and S.; asc. 180 ft. over E. slope.

39.40 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 13 and 24, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground with brass cap mkd.

44.65 Spur, slopes NE.; desc. 195 ft. over NW. slope.

51.20 Ravine, drains N. 10° W.; asc. 20 ft. over NE. slope.

52.35 Spur, slopes N.; desc. 100 ft. over NW. slope.

64.40 Ravine, drains N. 20° W.; asc. 75 ft. over NE. slope.

69.00 Spur, slopes N.; desc. 10 ft. over NW. slope.

70.00 Wet ravine, drains N. 80° E.; asc. 335 ft. over NE. slope.

78.80 The cor. of secs. 13 14, 23 and 24, perpetuated and recorded by Arnold G. Gibson, Registered Land Surveyor, No. 359, in 1967 monumented with an iron post, 1½ ins. diam., firmly set, protruding 6 ins. above ground, with bronze cap mkd.

A down hemlock, 30 ins. diam., bears S. 45° W., 16 lks. dist., no marks remaining.

A rotted hemlock stump, size indeterminate, bears N.30° W., 40 lks. dist., no marks remaining.
