69.10 Dry creek, 2 lks. wide, drains S. 40° W.; asc. 150 ft. over S. slope.

77.07 The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 10 and 15.

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From the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 14 and 15.

N. 87° 43' W., on the E. and W. center line of sec. 15.

Ascend 95 ft. over NE. slope, through scattering timber and light undergrowth.

5.45 Spur, slopes W.; desc. 310 ft. over NW. slope.

24.10 Ravine, drains S. 35° W.; asc. 10 ft. over SE. slope.

26.25 Spur, slopes S.; desc. 145 ft. over SW slope.

36.80 East Willis Creek, 3 lks. wide, course N. 15° E.; asc. 10 ft. over E. slope.

39.35 The center 1/4 sec. cor. of sec. 15.

Ascend 305 ft. over NE. slope.

44.20 East Willis Creek Road, 30 lks. wide, in curve, bears N. 60° W. and S. 25° E.

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GENERAL DESCRIPTION

Section 15, township 29 south, range 6 west, is located about 4 miles southeasterly of Dillard, Oregon. Access is gained by way of Willis Creek Road, which is paved. Elevations range from about 650 feet above sea level near the NW. corner of section 15, to about 1300 feet above sea level in the southwestern part of the section.

The southwestern portion of the section is predominately mountainous, with the remaining part of the section consisting of rolling hills.

Soil consists of rock and clay loam, which supports a forest of fir, cedar, hemlock, oak, myrtle, and maple
