 1.90 Dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears NW. and SE.
 14.40 Spur, slopes W., desc. 75 ft. over NW. slope.
 23.60 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course S. 60° W.; asc. 395 ft. over SW. slope.
 40.02 The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 6, on the E. bdy. of the Tp., monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set, protruding 15 ins. above ground, and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record of the 1965 dependent resurvey.

 12.90 Ravine, drains N. 30° W.; desc. 160 ft. over W. slope.
 20.15 Quines Creek, 10 lks. wide, course N. 50° W.; asc. 55 ft. over NE slope.
 27.80 Mining ditch, 8 lks. wide, 5 ft. deep, bears N. 30° W. and S. 30° E.
 30.55 Dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears N. 50° W. and S. 50° E.
 31.50 Dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears N. 60° W. and S. 60° E.
 32.45 Spur, slopes N. 20° W.; desc. 60 ft. along N. slope.
 38.87 Creek, 1 lk. wide, course N.; asc. 10 ft. along N. slope
 40.46 The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 12, monumented with an iron post 2½ ins. diam., firmly set, protruding 8 ins. above the ground, with brass cap mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record of the 1966 remonumentation.
