Willamette Meridian, Oregon

CHAINS

A fir, 25 ins. diam., bears N. 58° E., 25 lks. dist., no marks visible on pitched blaze.

A fir, 25 ins. diam., bears S. 75° E., 65 lks. dist., no marks visible on pitched blaze.

A fir, 20 ins. dia., bears S. 27° W., 14 lks. dist., no marks visible on pitched blaze.

A fir, 24 ins. diam., bears N. 31° W., 21 lks. dist., with illegible scribe marks visible on partially healed blaze.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky-clay, humus.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, yew, alder, maple, chinquapin, myrtle; undergrowth, vine maple, rhododendron, salmonberry, hazel, Oregon grape, slala, fern, and manzanita.

N. 1° 53' W. bet. secs. 19 and 20.

Ascend 496 ft. over S. slope, through heavy timber and moderate undergrowth.

14.05 Top of ascent, slopes SE.; desc. 3 ft. over NE. slope.

16.97 An original line tree, now a fir snag, 45 ins. diam., mkd. with 1 notch on N. face.

This point now becomes an angle point in the line.

N. 0° 54' W., beginning new measurement.

Descend 53 ft. over NE. slope.

7.75 Dirt road, 17 lks. wide, bears N. 80° E., curving to S.; and S. 70° W.

8.70 Ravine, drains N. 60° E.; asc. 14 ft. over SE slope.

11.45 Spur, slopes N. 60° E.; desc. 114 ft. over N. slope.

16.70 Ravine, drains N. 50° E.; asc. 3 ft. over SE. slope.

17.45 Spur, slopes N. 65° E.; desc. 75 ft. over NE slope.

20.75 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course S. 80° E.; asc. 66 ft. over S. slope.

22.70 Spur, slopes E.; desc. 7 ft. over N. slope.

23.07 Point for the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 19 and 20, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
