- 1.20 Spur, slopes N. 60° W.; desc. 25 ft. over NW. slope.
- 1.80 Wildcat Creek, 10 lks. wide, course N. 65° E.; asc. 42 ft. over SE. slope.
- 2.90 Spur, slopes S. 70° E.; desc. 33 ft. over NE. slope.
- 10.05 Ravine, drains. E.; asc. 17 ft. over SE. slope.
- 11.65 Spur, slopes S. 80° E.; desc. 100 ft. over NE. slope.
- 16.80 Wildcat Creek, 10 lks. wide, course N. 15° W.; asc 12 ft. over SW. slope.
- 23.70 Top of ascent, slopes N.; desc. 42 ft. over N. slope.
- 24.25 Dirt road, 20 lks. wide, bears S. 20° E. and N. 10° W.; curving to E.
- 26.00 Same dirt road, 20 lks. wide, bears N. 35° E. and S. 25° W. (?)
- 27.90 Creek, 3 lks. wide, course N. 40° W.; asc. 85 ft. over SW. slope.
- 30.00 Same dirt road, 20 lks. wide, bears N. 30° W. and S. 30° E.
- 30.90 Dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears N. 35° W. and S. 35° E.
- 34.85 Spur, slopes N. 65° W.; desc. 101 ft. over NW. slope.
- 38.75 East edge of gravelled road, 25 lks. wide, bears N. 10° E., and S. 10° W.; thence over road.
- 39.65 Point for the cor. of secs. 17, 18, 19, and 20, at proportionate distance, falls in a gravelled road, 30 lks. wide, bearing North and S. 10° W.; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., the top 6 ins. below the surface of a gravelled road, with brass cap marked.

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 06° E., 102 lks. dist., mkd. T30S R7W S20 BT.

A fir, 19 ins. diam., bears S. 45° W., 84 1/2 lks. dist., mkd. T30S R7W S19 BT.

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N. 27 1/2° W., 75 lks. dist., mkd. T30S R7W S18 BT.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky clay.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, pine, madrone, chinquapin; undergrowth, poison oak, rhododendron, manzanita, huckleberry, and salal.
