## CHAINS

The soil is composed of a rocky clay loam, from a few inches to several feet in depth, overlying a sandstone bedrock which is exposed in numerous outcroppings throughout the area.

No evidence of mineral activity was noted in the area covered by this resurvey.

The average of a considerable number of readings over all parts of the area give a value of  $19^{\circ} 39'$  E. for the mean magnetic declination. There is a range of up to  $1^{\circ} 15'$  in local attraction.
