The point for the cor. of secs. 7, 8, 17, and 18, determined at a point 4.80 chs. north and 17.05 chs. west from the SE. corner of Donation Land Claim No. 38, based upon the official record of the retracement and resurvey by Geroge S. Pershin, Deputy Surveyor, in 1896. This point is harmoniously related to items of topography based on Pershins retracement of section lines, North and West.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N. 83 1/2° E., 118 lks. dist., mkd. T22S R9W S8 BT.

A fir, 23 ins. diam., bears S. 56° E., 102 lks. dist., mkd. T22S R9W S17 BT.

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S. 48 1/2° W., 73 lks. dist., mkd. T22S R9W S18 BT.

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N. 54 1/2° W., 67 lks. dist., mkd. T22S R9W S7 BT.

Deposit broken brown glass at the base of the iron post.

Corner falls 20 lks. W. of a gravelled road, 20 lks. wide, bearing N. 40° E. and S. 40° W.

From this point, the cor. of secs. 8, 9, 16, and 17, perpetuated and record by the County Surveyor, in 1962, bears N. 88° 09' E., 76.82 chs. distant, monumented with an iron post, 1 1/2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 12 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd.

An iron pipe, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 10 ins. above ground, bears N. 64 1/2° E., 3 1/2 lks. dist.

and bearing trees mkd. by the County Surveyor, in 1962

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears N. 65° E., 32 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears S. 56° W., 203 lks. dist., with healed blaze.
