A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 31° E., 34 lks.  
dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S27 BT.

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 77° W., 18 lks.  
dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S28 BT.

N. 0° 02' W., beginning new measurement.

Descend 895 ft. over N. slope changing to steep rocky  
broken NE. slope.

34.65 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course N. 65° E.; asc. 45 ft. over  
SE. slope.

39.99 The cor. of secs. 21, 22, 27, and 28, perpetuated and  
recorded by the County Surveyor in 1968, monumented with  
an iron post, 1 in. diam., protruding 7 ins. above  
ground, firmly set, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N. 20° E., 25 lks.  
dist., with a healed blaze. This tree was  
remarked T25S R7W S22 CS in 1968. (Record,  
35 lks.)

A shattered and fallen fir, 24 ins. diam., bears  
S. 20 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E., 33 lks. dist., with scribe marks BT  
and other illegible marks visible on bark blaze.  
(Record, S. 22° E.)

A fir, 23 ins. diam., bears S. 46° W., 23 lks.  
dist., with scribe marks BT visible on opened  
lower blaze. This tree was remarked T25S R7W  
S28 CS BT in 1968.

A fir, 36 ins. diam., bears N. 52° W., 30 lks.  
dist., with a healed lower blaze and scribe  
marks T25S R7W S21 visible on bark blaze.

and a bearing tree mkd. by the County Surveyor in 1968

A fir, 11 ins. diam., bears S. 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° W., 37 lks.  
dist., with scribe marks T25S R7W S27 CS BT  
visible on open blaze.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky clay with rock outcroppings.

Timber, fir, cedar, oak, maple, chinquapin, and yew;  
undergrowth, young timber, fern salal, poison oak,  
hazel, arrowwood, huckleberry, vine maple, Oregon grape,  
and blackberry.

N. 0° 02' E., bet. secs. 21 and 22.

Ascend 30 ft. over S. slope, through heavy timber and  
dense undergrowth, across partially logged area.
