CHAINS

and bearing trees mkd. by Tracy

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 87° E., 8 lks. dist., with healed double blaze.

A fir, 11 ins. diam., bears N. 66° W., 15 lks. dist., with healed double blaze.

N. 0° 21' E., beginning new measurement.

Ascend 45 ft. over SE. slope, through scattering timber and dense undergrowth.

9.40 Ridge, bears N. 85° W., and S. 85° E.; desc. 435 ft. over NE . slope.

32.05 Creek, 3 lks. wide, course N. 80° W.; asc. 170 ft. over SW. slope.

39.79 Point for the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7, and 8, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Timber, fir, cedar, hemlock, alder, maple, madrone and chinquapin; undergrowth, vine maple, hazel, rhododendron, fern, salal, and Oregon grape.

From the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8, and 9, perpetuated and recorded by Glen McChesney, for Weyerhaeuser Timber Co. in 1959, subsequently perpetuated by Vernon R. Tracy, Deputy County Surveyor, in 1966, monumented with an iron post, 1 1/2 ins. diam., firmly set, protruding 10 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd.
