From the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32, and 33, on the S. bdy. of the Tp., perpetuated and recorded by Vernon Tracy, County Surveyor, in 1968, monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set, projecting 12 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd.

A sawed cedar stump, 25 ins. diam., bears N. 17° E.,
38 lks. dist., no marks visible on open blaze.
(Record, N. 20° E.)

and a bearing tree mkd. by Tracy

A sawed cedar stump, 20 ins. diam., bears N. 24° W.,
42 lks. dist., no marks visible.

and bearing trees of which I have no record

A sawed fir stump, 60 ins. diam., bears N. 40° E.,
77 1/2 lks. dist., with a galvanized nail with "W"
embossed on head, driven into base.

A sawed fir stump, 36 ins. diam., bears S. 54 1/2° E.,
149 lks. dist., with a galvanized nail with "W"
embossed on head, driven into base.

A sawed fir stump, 46 ins. diam., bears S. 57° W.,
167 lks. dist., with a galvanized nail with "W"
embossed on head, driven into base.

A sawed fir stump, 60 ins. diam., bears N. 57° W.,
81 1/2 lks. dist., with a galvanized nail with "W"
embossed on head, driven into base.

N. 1° 22' W., bet. secs. 32 and 33, marking and blazing the true line.

Ascend 125 ft. over SE. slope. through logged area.

- 6.60 Ravine, drains. S. 60° E.; asc. 130 ft. over SE. slope.
- 9.85 Spur, slopes N. 70° W.; desc. 175 ft. over NE. slopes; enter scattering timber and dense undergrowth, edge bears E. and W.
- 15.70 Creek, 5 lks. wide, course S. 65° E.; asc. 495 ft. over SW. slope.
- 25.20 Rock bluff, 40 ft. high, faces SE.
- 26.75 Spur, slopes S. 70° E.; desc. 145 ft. over NE. slopes.
- 32.10 Spur, slopes N. 30° E.; desc. 200 ft. over NW. slope.
- 37.30 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course N. 65° E.; desc. 10 ft. over NE. slope.
- 38.35 Creek, 5 lks. wide, course E.; asc. 75 ft. over S. slope.
