A hemlock, 12 ins. diam., bears N. 50° E., 57 lks. dist., with scribe marks T25S R8W S20 CS BT visible on open blaze.

A hemlock, 16 ins. diam., bears S. 85° E., 36 lks. dist., with scribe marks T25S R8W S29 CS BT visible on open blaze.

A hemlock, 16 ins. diam., bears S. 67° W., 27 lks. dist., with scribe marks T25S R8W S30 CS BT visible on open blaze.

Land, mountainous.
 Soil, rocky clay loam.
 Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, oak, maple, alder, and chinquapin; undergrowth, salal, ~~hazel~~, Oregon grape vine maple, and fern.

N. 89° 42' E., bet. secs. 20 and 29.

Ascend 210 ft. over NW. slope. through heavy timber and moderate undergrowth.

5.50 Gravelled road, 25 lks. wide, bears N. 30° E., curving to E., and S. 30° W., also spur, slopes S. 40° W., desc. 65 ft. over E. slope.

8.20 Head of ravine, drains S. 25° E.; asc. 5 ft. over SW. slope.

11.30 Spur, slopes S. 20° W.; desc. 80 ft. over SE. slope.

18.35 Creek, 3 lks. wide, course S. 55° W.; asc. 200 ft. over NW. slope.

22.90 Same gravelled road, 25 lks. wide, bears N. 15° E., curving to W., and S. 15° W.

25.65 Spur, slopes S. 20° W.; desc. 145 ft. over SE. slope.

31.90 Creek, 3 lks. wide, course S. 10° E.; asc. 30 ft. over SW. slope.

33.55 Spur, slopes S.; desc. 20 ft. over SE. slope.

34.40 Ravine, drains. S. 10° W.; asc. 35 ft. over W. slope.

36.00 Top of ascent, slopes S.; desc. 10 ft. over SE. slope.

39.77 The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 20 and 29, perpetuated and recorded by Vernon Tracy, County Surveyor, in 1968, monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set, projecting 8 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd.
