A fir, 22 ins. diam., bears N. 23 1/4° W., 31 lks.  
dist., with healed blaze.

A fir, 25 ins. diam., bears S. 77° W., 61 lks.  
dist., with healed blaze.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky clay.

Timber, fir, cedar, hemlock, yew, maple, chinquapin,  
dogwood, and madrone; undergrowth, vine maple, ocean  
spray, hazel, rhododendron, manzanita, salal, and fern.

28.60 Rock Creek, 40 lks. wide, course S. 75° W.; asc. 30 ft. over  
rolling bottom land.

34.50 McComas Creek, 20 lks. wide, course S. 20° W.; asc. 10  
ft. over rolling bottom land.

35.60 McComas Creek, 15 lks. wide, course S. 30° E.; asc. 95  
ft. over S. slope.

37.00 Gravelled road, 20 lks. wide, bears N. 35° E. and  
S. 35° W.

43.33 Point for the 1/4 sec. cor. of sec. 31 only, T. 25 S.,  
R. 2 W.
