A hemlock, 13 ins. diam., bears N. 61° E., 75 lks. dist., with scribe mark 2 visible on open blaze.

A hemlock, 13 ins. diam., bears S. 19° W., 14 lks. dist., with scribe marks T25S R2W visible on decaying blaze.

A hemlock, 28 ins. diam., bears N. 28° W., 16 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

A cedar, 25 ins. diam., bears S. 6 1/4° W., 42 lks. dist., with scribe marks T25S R2W S26 BT visible on open blaze.

and a new bearing tree

A hemlock, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 59° E., 137 lks. dist., mkd. T25S R2W S25 BT.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky clay loam.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, yew, madrone, and maple; undergrowth, salal, hazel, Oregon grape, arrowwood, vine maple, manzanita, and fern.

From the cor. of secs. 26, 27, 34, and 35, perpetuated and recorded by G. Robert Lecklider, RLS No. 362, in 1960, and remonumented by Floyd A. Brooks, in 1962, with an iron post, 2 1/2 ins. diam., firmly set, protruding 4 ins. above ground, alongside of which is a steel tube, 3/4 in. diam., firmly set, protruding 6 ins. above ground, alongside of which is the original basalt stone, 16 x 12 x 8 ins., firmly set, mkd. with 1 notch on S. and 2 notches on E. face, with brass cap mkd.
