## GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The area in township 25 south, range 2 west, included in this resurvey, is located about 8 1/2 miles easterly from the town of Glide, Oregon. The elevations in the area range from about 1,100 feet above sea level near the northwest portion of section 31, up to about 4,200 feet above sea level near the 1/4 section corner of sections 34 and 35.

The soil is generally composed of rocky clay. The area is timbered primarily of old growth fir, with stands of hemlock, cedar, pine, maple, and madrone. Undergrowth, consists chiefly of salal, vine maple, poison oak, hazel, arrowwood, Oregon grape, young timber, and fern. There is considerable logging being done in the area.

The area is drained by numerous creeks flowing northerly into Rock Creek, and southerly into the North Umpqua River.

Access is gained by way of State Highway Number 138 and a number of paved, gravelled and dirt roads branching from it.

No indication of mineral deposits was noted in the area.

A considerable number of readings throughout the area gives a mean magnetic declination of 19° 30' E. There is a range of 1° in local attraction.
