A fir snag, 40 ins. diam., bears S. 50° W., 22 lks.  
dist., with fragmentary scribe marks visible on  
bark blaze.

A madrone, 22 ins. diam., bears N. 35° W., 14 lks.  
dist., no marks visible.

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N. 38° E., 42 lks.  
dist., with healed blaze.

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 84 1/4° E., 57 lks.  
dist., with healed blaze.

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 37 1/2° W., 84 lks.  
dist., with healed blaze.

A fir stump, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 30° W., 75 lks.  
dist., with healed blaze.
