A hemlock, 13 ins. diam., bears S. 19° W., 29 lks.
dist., with scribe marks 1/4 S BT visible on opened
blaze.

and bearing trees mkd. by White and Corbin, in 1962

A fir, 34 ins. diam., bears N. 70 1/2° E., 50 lks.
dist., with healed blaze.

A fir, 41 ins. diam., bears S. 67° E., 126 lks.
dist., with healed blaze.

S. 87° 39' W., bet. secs. 2 and 35, marking and blazing
the true line.

Ascend 90 ft. over NE. slope, through scattering timber
and dense undergrowth.

7.15 Spur, slopes N. 50° W.; desc. 255 ft. over NW. slope.

21.50 Creek, 3 lks. wide, course S. 60° W.; asc. 290 ft. over
SE. slope.

30.20 Dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears N. and S.

38.50 Spur, slopes S.; desc. 10 ft. over SW. slope.

39.08 Point for the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34, and 35, at propor-
tionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the
original corner.
