**CHAINS**

Reset wooden post alongside iron post.

From this point, a local corner established by Roseburg Lumber Co., in 1973, bears N. 28° W., 0.05 chs. dist., monumented with an iron pipe, 1 1/2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 28 ins. above ground, from which bearing trees mkd. by Roseburg Lumber Co.:

A fir, 10 ins. diam., bears N. 77 1/2° E., 24 lks. dist., no marks visible on open blaze.

A fir, 4 ins. diam., bears S. 19° W., 12 lks. dist., no marks visible on open blaze.

S. 89° 39' W., beginning new measurement.

Ascend 25 ft. over E. slope, through light to moderate timber and undergrowth.

8.30 Top of ascent, slopes SE.: desc. 50 ft. over W. slope.

10.60 Creek, 5 lks. wide, course S. 15° E.; asc. 155 ft. over SE. slope.

20.01 The W 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 10 and 15, established by Roseburg Lumber Co., in 1973, monumented with a wooden post, 4 ins. sq., firmly set, projecting 4 ft. above ground, from which bearing trees mkd. by Roseburg Lumber Co.:

A fir, 13 ins. diam., bears N. 22 1/2° E., 30 1/2 lks. dist., no marks visible on open blaze.

A fir, 5 ins. diam., bears S. 83° E., 32 lks. dist., no marks visible on open blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 13 ins. diam., bears N. 41° E., 44 1/2 lks. dist., mkd. W 1/16 S10 BT.

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears S. 84° E., 51 lks. dist., mkd. W 1/16 S15 BT.

Reset wooden post alongside iron post.

N. 89° 57' W., beginning new measurement.

Ascend 150 ft. over E. slope.

20.01 The cor. of secs. 9, 10, 15, and 16.

Land, mountainous.  
Soil, rocky clay loam.  
Timber, fir, cedar, oak, hemlock, chinquapin, maple, and madrone; undergrowth, huckleberry, hazel, vine maple, poison oak, fern, blackberry, manzanita, arrowwood, and salal.
