CHAINS

An iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., set 24 ins. in the ground, for a reference monument, bears S. 62° W., 30 lks. dist., with brass cap mkd. 1/4 S4 RM 1967, and an arrow pointing to the corner.

The corner is located on the top of the cut bank on the S. side of a logging road, 30 lks. wide, bears NE. and NW., in a curve.

N 89° 48' W., beginning new measurement.

Ascend 105 ft. over SE. slope.

4.15 Spur, slopes N. 40° E.; desc. 165 ft. over W. slope.

5.30 Dirt road, 10 lks. wide, bears N. and S.

9.05 Ravine, drains N. 25° W.; asc. 145 ft. over broken NE. slope.

33.70 Top of ascent, slopes N.; desc. 45 ft. over NW. slope.

40.35 The cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32, and 33, remonumented by Bruce R. Rogers, Deputy Douglas County Surveyor, in 1965, with an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set, projecting 6 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 48 ins. diam., bears N. 65° E., 121 lks. dist., with scribe marks T20 visible on opened blaze. (Record, N. 75° E.)

A decayed fir stump, 26 ins. diam., bears S. 58° E., 34 lks. dist., with decayed blaze, no marks visible. (Record S. 55° E.)

A fir, 21 ins. diam., bears S. 71° W., 65 lks. dist., with scribe marks 21W visible on decayed face of opened blaze.

A sawed fir stump, 33 ins. diam., bears N. 50° W., 64 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

A hemlock, 11 ins. diam., bears N. 65° E., 49 lks. dist. with scribe marks T20S R5W S33 CS BT visible on open double blaze.

A fir, 7 ins. diam., bears N. 11° E., 10 1/2 lks. dist., with fragmentary scribe marks visible on pitched over double blaze.

A hemlock, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 48 1/4° E., 40 1/2 lks. dist., with scribe marks T21S R5W S4 CS BT visible on open double blaze.
