- 27.65 Spur, slopes N. 70° W.; desc. 85 ft. over NW. slope.
- 30.65 Ravine, drains S. 65° W.; asc. 180 ft. over S. slope.
- 40.02 The cor. of secs. 25, 30, 31, and 36, monumented by Milo E. Godfrey, Douglas County Surveyor, in 1962, with an iron post, 1 in. diam., firmly set, projecting 4 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 35 ins. diam., bears N. 58° E., 31 lks. dist., with scribe mark B visible on opened blaze.

A root hole, bears S. 17° E., 8 lks. dist., with a down fir, alongside, 36 ins. diam., with healed blaze, and scribe marks S31 Visible on bark.

A decayed fir snag, 30 ins. diam., bears N. 3° W., 65 lks. dist., no marks visible.

A fir, 37 ins. diam., bears S. 19 3/4° E., 73 lks. dist., with fragmentary scribe marks visible on pitched over double blaze.

A cedar, 11 ins. diam., bears S. 57 1/4° W., 16 1/2 lks. dist., with scribe marks T20S R6W S36 DCS BT visible on open double blaze.

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N. 49 1/2° W., 58 lks. dist., with healed double blaze.

Add the marks, BLM 1967, to the brass cap.

The corner point is located on top of ridge, divides Smith river and Siuslaw River drainages, bears N. 40° E., and S. 10° W.

Land, mountainous.  
Soil, sandy clay loam.  
Timber, fir, cedar, hemlock, maple, alder, chinquapin. and madrone; undergrowth, vine maple, salal, Oregon grape, hazel, ceanothus, slamonberry, huckleberry, blackberry, arrowwood, rhododendron, poison oak and fern.

- N. 0° 06' E., bet. secs. 25 and 30.
- Descend 320 ft. over N. slope, across logged area.
- 6.85 Ravine, drains N. 80° W.; asc. slightly over SW. slope.
- 7.50 Ravine, drains S. 45° W.; asc. 185 ft. over SW. slope.
- 16.55 Spur, slopes S. 60° W.; desc. 145 ft. over N. slope.
