GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The line resurveyed is located about 16 miles east of Powers, Oregon. The area is drained by the West Fork of Cow Creek and a number of its tributaries. The elevation ranges from about 1,500 feet above sea level to about 2,300 feet above sea level along the line resurveyed.

Access into the area is by way of a few gravelled and dirt roads.

The soil is rocky clay suited primarily for growing timber. Timber consists of fir, chinquapin, madrone, cedar, yew, and alder; with undergrowth of salal, vine maple, ceanothus, hazel, Oregon grape, and fern.

No evidence of mineral deposits was noted along the line resurveyed.

The average of several readings along the line resurveyed gives a mean magnetic declination of $19^{\circ} 00'$ E. There is a range of $0^{\circ} 30'$ in local attraction.
