A fir, 14 ins. diam., bears S. 1 1/2° W., 104 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears N. 81 1/2° W., 55 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, in a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky clay loam.

Timber, fir, cedar, hemlock, yew, madrone, maple, chinquapin, and alder; undergrowth, live oak, poison oak, salal, vine maple, hazel, Oregon grape, manzanita, Huckleberry, blackcap, blackberry, and fern.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land covered in this resurvey is located approximately 7 miles northerly of the town of Glendale, Oregon. Access into the area is gained by way of a paved road, turning to gravel, leading up Mc Cullough Creek, over the high ridge, and intersecting Middle Creek Road, which leads to Riddle, Oregon.

Elevations range from about 2,240 feet above sea level at the 1/4 section corner of sections 5 and 6, to about 3,840 feet above sea level near the 1/4 section corner of sections 5 and 8. The area is drained by numerous small creeks flowing southeasterly into Middle Creek.

Timber in the area consists primarily of fir, cedar, and hemlock, with stands of pine, maple, madrone, alder, and chinquapin. The undergrowth is chiefly live oak, poison oak, salal, Oregon grape, huckleberry, blackberry, blackcap, manzanita, hazel, vine maple, and fern.

No mineral deposits were noted along the lines resurveyed. There are no permanent residents in the area.

The average of a considerable number of readings throughout the area gives a value of 19° 30' E. for the mean magnetic declination. There is a range of 1° in local attraction.
