Ascend 70 ft. over NE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

3.00 Spur, slopes N.; desc. 20 ft. over NW. slope.

8.00 Ravine, drains N. 50° E.; asc. 125 ft. over E. slope. changing to SE. slope.

19.00 Spur, slopes S.; desc. 30 ft. over SW. slope.

20.30 Ravine, drains S.; asc. 65 ft. over SE. slope.

22.00 Spur, slopes S.; desc. 80 ft. over SW. slope.

24.40 Ravine, drains S.; asc. 395 ft. over SE. slope.

40.00 Spur, slopes N. 70° E.; asc. 5 ft. along N. slope.

42.08 Point for the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 27 and 34, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
