CHAINS

Land, mountainous.
Soil, rocky clay.
Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, chinquapin, alder, madrone, and yew; undergrowth, huckleberry, vine maple, rhododendron, manzanita, arrowwood, hazel, salmonberry, thimbleberry, Oregon grape, salal, and fern.

N. 2° 43' E., bet. secs. 16 and 17.

Ascend 30 ft. over S. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.

7.90 Ridge, bears E. and W.; desc. 325 ft. over general N. slope.

31.50 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course NE.; asc. 175 ft. over SE. slope.

37.00 Spur, slopes E.; desc. 250 ft. over NE. slope.

41.94 Point for the 1/4 sec. cor. of secs 16 and 17, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 6 ins. in the ground, to solid rock, in a mound of stone, 5 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.

Descend 2 ft. over N. slope.

42.15 Creek, 2 lks. wide, course N. 30° W.; asc. 225 ft. over SW. slope.

60.00 Spur, slopes NW.; desc. 550 ft. over N. slope.

77.60 Kentucky Creek, 10 lks. wide, course N. 75° W.; asc. 80 ft. over S. slope.

83.88 Point for the cor. of secs 8, 9, 16, and 17, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
