	<p>A fir stump, 28 ins. diam., bears N. $12\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., $82\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist., with scribe marks S BT visible on partially healed blaze.</p> <p>A fir stump, 23 ins. diam., bears N. $61\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., $88\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist., no marks visible on open and decayed blaze.</p> <p>and new bearing trees</p> <p>A madrone, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 51° E., $21\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist., mkd. NW 1/16 S27 BT.</p> <p>A fir, 6 ins. diam., bears N. $27\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 28 lks. dist., mkd. NW 1/16 S27 BT.</p> <p>From this point, a local corner established and recorded by George J. Wenderoth, Deputy County Surveyor, in 1947, bears S. $8^{\circ} 50'$ E., 0.105 chs. dist., monumented with an iron pipe, 1 in. diam., firmly set, protruding 10 ins. above ground. This corner point was not accepted because its position is based on Wenderoth's $\frac{1}{2}$ section corner of sections 26 and 27, which was not utilized.</p> <p>Ascend 220 ft. over SW. slope, changing to S. slope.</p> <p>30.80 Spur, slopes S. 60° W.; desc. 220 ft. over NW. slope.</p> <p>39.10 Dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears N. 50° E. and S. 50° W.</p> <p>40.03 The W 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 22 and 27.</p>
