CHAINS 20.22	The center $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 33.
	N. $89^{\circ} 52'$ W., beginning new measurement.
	Ascend 480 ft. over E. slope, through scattered timber and dense undergrowth.
20.86	The center W $\frac{1}{16}$ sec. cor. of sec. 33, established and recorded by Frank Cain, Deputy County Surveyor, in 1909, subsequently perpetuated and recorded by George J. Wenderoth, Deputy County Surveyor, in 1949, monumented with an iron pipe, $\frac{1}{2}$ in. diam., firmly set, protruding 6 ins. above ground, from which the remains of bearing trees mkd. by Cain:
	A sawed fir stump, 36 ins. diam., bears N. $51\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ E., 31 lks. dist., with scribe marks CS visible on open blaze.
	A fir, 35 ins. diam., bears S. $50\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., $28\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist., with illegible scribe marks visible on partially opened upper blaze and with healed lower blaze.
	At the corner point
	Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, directly over iron pipe, with brass cap mkd.
	$\frac{C^W \frac{1}{16}}{S \ 33} C$ 1972
	from which a new bearing tree
	A twin fir, 35 ins. diam., bears N. $31\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., $57\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist., mkd. CW $\frac{1}{16}$ S33 BT.
	S. $89^{\circ} 39'$ W., beginning new measurement.
	Ascend 420 ft. over NE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
16.80	Spur, slopes N. $20^{\circ}$ E.; desc. 75 ft. over NW. slope.
20.82	The $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 32 and 33.
	From the center E $\frac{1}{16}$ sec. cor. of sec. 33.
	N. $2^{\circ} 29'$ W., on the N. and S. center line of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec. 33.
	Ascend 60 ft. over SW. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.
20.04	Intersect a local corner, established and recorded by George J. Wenderoth, Deputy County Surveyor, in 1949, determined from the remains of bearing trees mkd. by Wenderoth:
	A fir, 17 ins. diam., bears N. $70^{\circ}$ E., 35 lks. dist., with healed double blaze.
