Eppstein, Deputy County Surveyor, in 1926, and further perpetuated and recorded by Ben B. Irving, County Surveyor, in 1948, and James W. (Record, S. 5° E.)</p> <p>and a bearing tree mkd. by Eppstein</p> <p>A white oak, 16 ins. diam., bears S. $9\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ W., $161\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist., with healed blaze.</p> <p>and a bearing tree mkd. by Irving</p> <p>A white oak, 21 ins. diam., bears N. 70° W., $165\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist., with scribe marks T30S R5W S7 CS 2741 BT visible on partially healed blaze.</p> <p>and bearing trees mkd. by Byron</p> |
