

Dependent Resurvey, Portion of Subdivisional Lines, **15583**  
 T. 28 S., R. 8 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon

CHAINS

A hemlock, 26 ins. diam., bears S.  $3\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$  E., 60 lks. dist., with scribe marks T28S R8W S visible on partially healed blaze. (Record, S.  $2\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E.)

A fir, 28 ins. diam., bears S.  $45^{\circ}$  W.,  $59\frac{1}{2}$  lks. dist., with healed double blaze. (Record, 62 lks.)

A sawed fir stump, 13 ins. diam., bears N.  $88^{\circ}$  W., 64 lks. dist., no marks visible. (Record, N.  $86^{\circ}$  W.)

A fir snag, 13 ins. diam., bears N.  $83\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W., 71 lks. dist., with scribe marks T28S R8W S16 CS visible on open double blaze.

and a bearing tree mkd. by Roseberry, Berry, Popken, and Garrison

A fir, 13 ins. diam., bears N.  $57^{\circ}$  W., 141 lks. dist., with scribe marks T28S R8 S visible on partially open blaze.

S.  $89^{\circ} 39'$  W., bet. secs. 16 and 21.

Ascend 25 ft. over NE. slope, through scattering timber and dense undergrowth.

- 2.20 Spur, slopes N.  $15^{\circ}$  E.; desc. 80 ft. over NW. slope.
- 8.90 Ravine, drains N.  $5^{\circ}$  W.; asc. 15 ft. over NE. slope.
- 17.70 Top of ascent, slopes N.; desc. 2 ft. over NW. slope.
- 27.50 Creek, 4 lks. wide, course N.  $35^{\circ}$  E.; asc. 180 ft. over SE. slope.
- 37.60 Spur, slopes S.  $45^{\circ}$  E.; desc. 20 ft. over SW. slope.
- 39.60 Bottom of descent, slopes W.; asc. 15 ft. over SE. slope.
- 40.40 Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 16 and 21, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 17 ins. diam., bears N.  $82^{\circ}$  W.,  $45\frac{1}{2}$  lks. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S16 BT.

A fir, 16 ins. diam., bears S.  $62^{\circ}$  W.,  $31\frac{1}{2}$  lks. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S21 BT.

Ascend 10 ft. over SE. slope.

- 40.60 Spur, slopes S.  $5^{\circ}$  W.; desc. 20 ft. over SW. slope.
- 45.65 Creek, 5 lks. wide, course S.  $70^{\circ}$  E.; asc. 400 ft. over NE. slope.
