Jelley</p> <p>A hemlock, 14 ins. diam., bears S. 36° E., 76 lks. dist., with fragmentary scribe marks visible on open blaze.</p> <p>A hemlock stump, 27 ins. diam., bears S. 15° W., 38 lks. dist., no marks visible. (Record, S. 12° W., 40 lks.)</p> <p>and a bearing tree not of record</p> <p>A hemlock, 32 ins. diam., bears S. 1° W., 99 lks. dist., with scribe marks 28S R8W S4 SC CS BT visible on open blaze.</p> <p>Add marks 1975 to brass cap.</p> <p>Land, mountainous. Soil, rocky clay. Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, oak, myrtle, alder, and chinquapin; undergrowth, salal, rhododendron, Oregon grape, vine maple, and fern.</p>
	<p>From the cor. of secs. 4, 5, 8, and 9.</p> <p>S. 89° 34' W., bet. secs. 5 and 8.</p> <p>Ascend 20 ft. over SE. slope, through heavy timber and dense undergrowth.</p>
2.35	Spur, slopes S. 35° E.; desc. 85 ft. over SW. slope.
6.35	Ravine, drains S.; asc. 20 ft. over SE. slope.
8.45	Spur, slopes S. 55° E.; desc. 15 ft. over SW. slope.
9.00	Creek, 2 lks. wide, course S. 50° E.; asc. 370 ft. over SE. slope.
20.95	Spur, slopes S. 5° E.; desc. 85 ft. over SW. slope.
24.20	Ravine, drains S. 5° E.; asc. 35 ft. over SE. slope.
25.60	Creek, 1 lk. wide, course S. 40° E.; asc. 220 ft. over SE. slope.
32.50	Base of cliff, faces E.; asc. 480 ft. over cliff.
37.80	Top of cliff, faces SE.; asc. 5 ft. over SW. slope.
