CHAINS

Soil in the area is composed of rocky clay, varying from a few inches to several feet in depth.

Timber consists of fir, cedar, pine, hemlock, yew, madrone, alder, and maple; with undergrowth of huckleberry, salal, vine maple, rhododendron, live oak, and fern.

The principal use of the area is for timber resources. No mineral deposits were noted during the course of the survey.

The average of a few readings on the line surveyed gives a value of 20° 00' E., for the mean magnetic declination. There is a range of 1° in local attraction.
