CHAINS

- Ascend 80 ft. over NE. slope.
- 3.00 Ridge dividing O'Shea Creek and Canyon Creek drainages, bears N. 30° W. and S. 30° E.; also underground gas pipe line, bears same; desc. 340 ft. along SW. slope.
- 13.70 Ravine, drains S. 30° W.; asc. 15 ft. over SE. slope.
- 15.70 Top of ascent, slopes SW.; desc. 25 ft. over SE. slope.
- 19.37 The E 1/16 sec. cor. of sec. 2 only, monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set, protruding 5 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 25 ins. diam., bears S. 33° W., 235 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

Descend 5 ft. over nearly level ground.

- 2.65 Spur, slopes SW.; desc. 500 ft. over SW. slope.
- 19.36 The ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 2 only, monumented with an iron post, 2½ ins. diam., firmly set, protruding 5 ins. above ground, with brass cap mkd.

A madrone, 22 ins. diam., bears S. 10° E., 32½ lks. dist., with scribe mark T visible on opened blaze.

A madrone, 23 ins. diam., bears N. 27½° W., 32 lks. dist., with scribe marks ¼ S35 CS BT visible on partially healed blaze.

A cedar, 17 ins. diam., bears S. 40° E., 43 lks. dist., with scribe marks ¼ S2 CS BT visible on partially healed blaze.

and a bearing tree mkd. by Jelley, Roseberry, and Brooks

A fir, 20 ins. diam., bears S. 46° W., 105½ lks. dist., with healed blaze.

S. 89° 28' W., beginning new measurement.

Descend 35 ft. over SW. slope.
