CHAINS 23.70	West Fork Canyon Creek, 20 lks. wide, course N. 45° E.; asc. 25 ft. over SW. slope.
27.10	Gravelled road, 40 lks. wide, bears N. 45° E. and S. 45° W.
29.10	Spur, slopes E.; desc. 85 ft. over NE. slope.
31.65	Gravelled road, 40 lks. wide, bears N. 30° W. and S. 30° E.
33.50	Bottom of descent, slopes E.; asc. 50 ft. over broken E. slope.
37.10	Gravelled road, 40 lks. wide, bears N. 30° E. and S. 30° W.
39.56	Point for the cor. of secs. 10, 11, 14, and 15, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.
