CHAINS

The following field notes describe the remonumentation of certain original corner points, township 20 south, range 6 west, of the Willamette Meridian, Oregon, as provided for in the General Special Instructions, Group No. 350, Oregon, dated May 3, 1957, "Investigations of Collateral or Physical Evidence of Corner Positions and Accessories Followed by Remonumentation of Corner Points, with New Accessories when Needed."

The remonumentation of original corner points was made at the request of the Eugene District Manager, for administrative purposes of the Bureau of Land Management. The mean magnetic declination is 21° E.

West Boundary, T. 20 S., R. 6 W.,  
Willamette Meridian, Oregon

(Remonumenting a corner established by John W. McClung, Deputy Surveyor, in 1872 and changed to a corner of minimum control by Thomas E. Todd, Deputy Surveyor, in 1891)

The cor. of secs. 19 and 30 only, perpetuated and recorded by Wilford N. Haines, Registered Land Surveyor No. 239, in 1958, monumented with a T shaped iron rod, 36 ins. long, firmly set 24 ins. in the ground, with a brass disc mkd. Wilford N. Haines 239 Survey Point Drain Ore., from which the remains of the original bearing trees:

A fir, 52 ins. diam., bears N. 73° E., 17 lks. dist., with fragmentary scribe marks visible on opened blaze. Remarked by Haines in 1958; T20S R6W S19 BT 363 on bark blaze.

A decayed maple root crown, size indeterminate, bears S. 32½° E., 31 lks. dist., no marks remaining.

and a bearing tree marked by Haines in 1958

A fir, 19 ins. diam., bears S. 68° E., 61 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 18 ins. diam., bears N. 35° E., 54 lks. dist., mkd. T20S R6W S19 BT.
