CHAINS

The following field notes are those of the dependent resurvey of a portion of the west boundary of township 27 south, range 8 west, and a portion of the subdivisional lines of township 27 south, range 9 west, Willamette Meridian, Oregon.

The history of surveys pertaining to this resurvey, is as follows:

The west boundary of township 27 south, range 8 west, was surveyed by William P. Heydon, in 1896.

The line between sections 25 and 30, on the east boundary of township 27 south, range 9 west, was retraced, and a portion of the subdivisional lines of township 27 south, range 9 west, was surveyed by Samuel W. Lackland, in 1897, at which time he established closing corners against the west boundary of township 27 south, range 8 west, on all section lines, except the line between sections 25 and 36.

The survey was executed in accordance with the specifications set forth in the Manual of Surveying Instructions, 1973, and Special Instructions, dated February 24, 1976, under Group Number 903, Oregon.

The directions of the lines were determined by deflection angles determined from azimuths obtained by direct solar observations.

Preliminary to the resurvey, the lines of the original survey were retraced and search was made for all corners and other calls of the record. Identified corners were remonumented in their original positions. Lost corners were reestablished and remonumented at proportionate positions based on the official record. The retracement data were thoroughly verified and only the true line field notes are given herein. Only those lines bounding or crossing public lands were blazed. All lines not forming a closure were measured twice.

The geographic position of the corner of sections 25, 30, 31, and 36, on the east boundary of township 27 south, range 9 west, as scaled from the Camas Valley, Oregon, quadrangle map, published by the United States Geological Survey, in 1955, is as follows:

Latitude 43° 11.1' N. Longitude 123° 42.1' W.

The mean magnetic declination is 18° 45' E.
