Transitman, in 1917)</p> <hr style="width: 20%; margin: 10px auto;"/> <p>From the cor. of secs. 23 and 26 only, monumented with a limestone, 14 x 9 x 6 ins., firmly set 10 ins. in the ground, mkd. with 2 notches on S. and 4 notches on N. edges, subsequently perpetuated and recorded by James W. Byron, County Surveyor, in 1959, with a ¾ in. iron rod, firmly set, protruding 6 ins. above ground alongside, from which the remains of the bearing trees mkd. by Strickler:</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A root hole, bears N. 33½° W., 24 lks. dist., with a down fir alongside, 24 ins. diam., with illegible scribe marks visible on opened blaze.</p> <p>and bearing trees mkd. by Byron</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A madrone, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 73° W., 22 lks. dist., with healed blaze.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A fir, 26 ins. diam., bears N. 56° W., 70 lks. dist., with healed blaze.</p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;">A cedar, 44 ins. diam., bears S. 71° W., 148 lks. dist., with scribe marks T27S R4W S26 BT visible on open blaze.</p>
