CHAINS

A madrone, 22 ins. diam., bears S. 80° W.,
48 lks. dist., with healed blaze.
(Record, 50 lks.)

and bearing trees mkd. by Mensch

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N. 24° E.,
14 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

A cedar, 16 ins. diam., bears N. 68½° W.,
41 lks. dist., with healed blaze.
(Record, N. 70° W.)

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky clay loam.

Timber, fir, hemlock, cedar, maple, madrone, chinquapin,
and oak; undergrowth, poison oak, Oregon grape, hazel,
manzanita, huckleberry, salal, and fern.

N. 0° 56' E., bet. secs. 27 and 28.

Descend 155 ft. over broken NW. slope.

Intersect Cor. No. 1 of Bell Placer Mine, determined at
record bearing and distance from the remains of the
original bearing trees:

A sawed fir stump, 26 ins. diam., bears
N. 82½° E., 15 lks. dist., with scribe
marks BT visible on opened blaze.
