and a new bearing tree

A fir, 5 ins. diam., bears N.  $11\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E., 148 lks.  
dist., mkd. X BT.

Ascend 105 ft. over SE. slope.

9.05 Ridge, bears N.  $50^{\circ}$  E. and S.  $40^{\circ}$  W., also dirt road, 20  
lks. wide, bears same; desc. 95 ft. over NW. slope.

19.99 Point for the N 1/16 sec. cor. of sec. 24 only, monument-  
ed by person(s) unknown, with an iron pipe, 1 in. diam.,  
firmly set, projecting 8 ins. above ground, from which  
bearing trees of which I have no record:

A fir, 11 ins. diam., bears N.  $33\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E., 21 lks.  
dist., with healed double blaze.

A fir, 11 ins. diam., bears S.  $40\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W., 12 lks.  
dist., with healed double blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins.  
in the ground, directly atop the iron pipe, with brass  
cap mkd.

from which new bearing trees

A fir, 13 ins. diam., bears S.  $75^{\circ}$  W., 24 lks.  
dist., mkd. N 1/16 S24 BT.

A fir, 8 ins. diam., bears N.  $17\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W., 63 lks.  
dist., mkd. N 1/16 S24 BT.

N.  $1^{\circ} 23'$  E., beginning new measurement.

Descend 425 ft. over NW. slope.

19.99 The cor. of secs. 13 and 24 only, perpetuated and record-  
ed by John H. Markham, Jr., RPE No. 2880, in 1957,  
monumented with the original basalt stone, 15 x 7 x 6  
ins., firmly set, projecting 6 ins. above ground, mkd.  
with 3 grooves on N. and S. faces, alongside of which is  
an iron pipe,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 10  
ins. above ground, from which the remains of the original  
bearing trees:

A fir snag, 35 ins. diam., bears S.  $70^{\circ}$  W., 186  
lks. dist., with scribe marks T29S R3W BT visible  
on open blaze. (Record, S.  $71^{\circ}$  W.)

A fir, 39 ins. diam., bears N.  $18\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W., 257 lks.  
dist., with scribe marks 3 BT visible on open  
blaze. (Record, N.  $17^{\circ}$  W.)

and bearing trees mkd. by Markham

A fir, 13 ins. diam., bears S.  $31^{\circ}$  W., 27 lks.  
dist., with healed double blaze.
