Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the North Boundary,
T. 29 S., R. 3 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon

CHAINS

- 10.20 Creek, 3 lks. wide, course N. 65° W.; desc. 5 ft. over NW. slope.
- 12.60 Same creek, course S. 55° W.; desc. 125 ft. over NW. slope.
- 24.55 Same creek, 5 lks. wide, course N. 55° W.; desc. 60 ft. over NW. slope.
- 28.50 Abandoned dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears S. 60° W. and S. 70° E., in curve.
- 30.90 South Myrtle Creek, 12 lks. wide, course S. 50° W.; desc. 20 ft. along creek bottom.
- 36.10 South Myrtle Creek, 12 lks. wide, course N. 50° W.; desc. slightly along creek bottom.
- 37.16 Point selected for the witness cor. to the cor. of secs. 1 and 2 only.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground, and in a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, to top, with brass cap mkd.

A fir, 5 ins. diam., bears S. 17° E., 46½ lks. dist., mkd. X BT.

An alder, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 25° W., 196½ lks. dist., mkd. X BT on bark.

Descend slightly along creek bottom.

- 37.86 Point for the cor. of secs. 1 and 2, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. The corner point is located in South Myrtle Creek, 12 lks. wide, course S. 60° W., where it is impracticable to establish a permanent monument.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, clay loam.

Timber, fir, cedar, hemlock, madrone, alder, and maple; undergrowth, arrowwood, rhododendron, hazel, huckleberry, fern, salal, and Oregon grape.

N. 89° 29' W., on the N. bdy. of sec. 2.

Descend 40 ft. along creek bottom, through moderate timber and undergrowth.

- 3.00 South Myrtle Creek, 12 lks. wide, course N. 65° W.; desc. slightly along creek bottom.
- 15.30 Same creek, course S.; asc. 425 ft. over SE. slope.
- 18.10 Center of asphaltic surfaced road, 45 lks. wide, bears N. 40° E. and S. 40° W.
