

Dependent Resurvey, Portion of Subdivisional Lines,  
T. 29 S., R. 4 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon

CHAINS

S. 76° 17' W., beginning new measurement.

Ascend 180 ft. over general E. slope.

5.60 Spur, slopes N. 35° E.; desc. 140 ft. over NW. slope.

15.75 Ravine, drains N.; asc. 145 ft. over NE. slope.

19.02 The 1/4 sec. cor. of secs. 24 and 25, reestablished at proportionate distance by Arthur R. Evans, Deputy County Surveyor, in 1949, monumented with an iron pipe, 1 1/2 ins. diam., firmly set, projecting 8 ins. above ground. There is no remaining evidence of the original corner; therefore, this position is accepted as the corner, from which bearing trees mkd. by Evans:

A cedar, 30 ins. diam., bears N. 12 1/4° W., 43 lks. dist., with scribe marks 1/4 S24 CS BT visible on partially healed blaze and a brass disc nailed to tree mkd. DOUGLAS COUNTY SURVEYOR 1/4 CORNER 24 25 set by REG. ENGR. 2741 ORE.

A fir, 9 ins. diam., bears S. 18 1/2° E., 41 1/2 lks. dist., with healed blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2 1/2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, directly over iron pipe, with brass cap mkd.

Ascend 140 ft. over NE. slope.

4.40 Top of ascent, slopes N.; desc. 10 ft. along N. slope.

7.40 Ridge, bears S. 80° E. and S. 80° W., also dirt road, 15 lks. wide, bears S. 65° E. and N. 80° W.; desc. 50 ft. over SW. slope.

16.00 Bottom of descent, slopes S. 20° W.; asc. 30 ft. over SE. slope.

19.02 The W 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 24 and 25, established by Arthur R. Evans, Deputy County Surveyor, in 1949, monumented with an iron pipe, 3/4 in. diam., firmly set, projecting 8 ins. above ground, from which bearing trees mkd. by Evans:

A madrone, 20 ins. diam., bears N. 74 1/2° W., 33 1/2 lks. dist., with scribe marks W 1/16 S24 CS BT visible on partially healed blaze.

A madrone, 17 ins. diam., bears S. 4° E., 39 lks. dist., with scribe marks W 1/16 S25 CS BT visible on partially healed blaze.
