

Dependent Resurvey, Portion of Subdivisional Lines
T. 29 S., R. 4 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon

CHAINS

A madrone, 23 ins. diam., bears N. $69\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 42 lks. dist., no marks visible on decayed blaze.

A madrone, 25 ins. diam., bears N. 2° W., $46\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist., no marks visible on decayed blaze.

This corner is located on a spur, slopes N. 15° W.; desc. 430 ft. over NE. slope.

39.10 South Myrtle Creek, 40 lks. wide, course N. 60° W., enter field, edge bears N. 60° W. and S. 60° E.

39.25 True point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 21 and 22, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. The corner point falls in N. edge of South Myrtle Creek, where it is impracticable to establish a permanent monument.

Ascend 5 ft. over SW. slope.

39.75 Point selected for the witness $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. to secs. 21 and 22.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A cedar, 15 ins. diam., bears S. $49\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ E., 45 lks. dist., mkd. X WC BT.

A cedar, 7 ins. diam., bears N. $56\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 72 lks. dist., mkd. X WC BT.

Ascend 5 ft. over nearly level bottom land.

41.85 Intersect the S. bdy. of Donation Land Claim No. 38, and point for the crossing closing corner.

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A cedar, 17 ins. diam., bears S. $16\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 13 lks. dist., mkd. T29S R4W S22 CCC BT.

A fir, 27 ins. diam., bears S. $70\frac{3}{4}^{\circ}$ W., $124\frac{1}{2}$ lks. dist., mkd. T29S R4W S21 CCC BT.

From this point, the SW. cor. of Claim No. 38, identical with the SE. cor. of Claim No. 39, bears S. $89^{\circ} 51'$ W., 15.35 chs. dist., hereinafter described.
