

Dependent Resurvey, Portion of Subdivisional Lines,
T. 29 S., R. 4 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon

CHAINS

Land, mountainous.
Soil, rocky clay.
Timber, fir, cedar, oak, madrone, yew, maple, dogwood,
pine, and cascara; undergrowth, fern, salal, poison oak,
vine maple, Oregon grape, blackberry, thimbleberry, and
hazel.

From the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 9, and 10.

N. 82° 18' W., bet. secs. 4 and 9.

Descend 340 ft. over NW. slope, through light timber and
moderate undergrowth.

9.65 Wet ravine, drains N. 50° W.; desc. 50 ft. over NW.
slope.

15.95 The E 1/16 sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 9, established by
John H. Markham, Jr., Registered Engineer No. 2880, in
1959. This position is accepted as the corner and was
determined at record distance from Markham's bearing
trees:

A cedar, 62 ins. diam., bears N. 52½° E., 40 lks.
dist., with scribe marks L16 S4 BT visible on
open blaze.

A fir, 64 ins. diam., bears S. 47° W., 47 lks.
dist., with scribe marks L2 S9 BT visible on
bark.

A maple, 11 ins. diam., bears N. 54½° W., 24 lks.
dist., with illegible scribe marks visible on
partially healed blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 24 ins.
in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

E 1/16 $\frac{S 4}{S 9}$
1969

N. 81° 13' W., beginning new measurement.

Descend 10 ft. over NW. slope.

1.30 Draw, drains N.; asc. 120 ft. over NE. slope.

5.80 Spur, slopes N.; desc. 55 ft. over NW. slope.

10.40 Spur, slopes N. 80° W.; desc. 155 ft. over W. slope.

15.92 The ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 9, reestablished by pro-
portionate measurement by John H. Markham, Jr., Register-
ed Engineer No. 2880, in 1959, monumented with an iron
pipe, ½ in. diam., firmly set, projecting 12 ins. above
ground. There is no remaining evidence of the original
corner; therefore, this position is accepted as the
corner, from which the remains of bearing trees mkd. by
Markham:

A fir snag, 10 ins. diam., bears N. 10° E., 38
lks. dist., with scribe marks S4 visible on
partially healed blaze.
