Dependent Resurvey of Donation Land Claim No. 38,  
T. 29 S., R. 4 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon

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T. 29 S., R. 4 W., Willamette Meridian, Oregon

(Restoring the survey by Dennis Hathorn,  
U. S. Deputy Surveyor, in 1857)

From the SW. cor. of Donation Land Claim No. 38, identical with the SE. cor. of Claim No. 39, perpetuated and recorded by A. Boyer, Deputy County Surveyor, in 1938, from evidence no longer in existence, monumented with an axle,  $\frac{3}{4}$  in. diam., firmly set, projecting 3 ins. above ground. This corner is accepted as the best available evidence of the original corner position, from which the remains of bearing trees mkd. by James W. Byron, Deputy County Surveyor, in 1963:

A red fir snag, 6 ins. diam., bears N.  $62\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E., 64 lks. dist., with scribe marks SW DLC 38 CS BT visible on partially healed double blaze.

A fir, 15 ins. diam., bears N.  $42\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  W.,  $80\frac{1}{2}$  lks. dist., with healed double blaze.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 28 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, directly over inverted axle, with brass cap mkd.

from which a new bearing tree

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears N.  $85^{\circ}$  E., 102 lks. dist., mkd. SW DLC 38 BT.

Corner is located in cor. of wire fences, with fences extending N., E., and W.

N.  $89^{\circ} 51'$  E., along the S. bdy. of Claim No. 38.

Descend 55 ft. over NE. slope, through heavy reproduction and dense undergrowth, along fence line.

6.80 Spring seepage, 1 lk. wide, bears NW.; desc. 25 ft. over bottom land.

11.50 South Myrtle Creek, 30 lks. wide, course N.  $15^{\circ}$  W.; asc. 20 ft. over bottom land, also enter open fields, edge bears N.  $15^{\circ}$  W. and S.  $15^{\circ}$  E.

15.35 The crossing closing cor. of secs. 21 and 22, at intersection with the S. bdy. of Claim No. 38, hereinbefore described.

From this point, the witness  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. to secs. 21 and 22, bears S.  $1^{\circ} 10'$  W., 2.10 chs. dist.

Descend 20 ft. over bottom land.

19.80 South Myrtle Creek, 25 lks. wide, course SW.; asc. 20 ft. over bottom land.
