A root hole, bears S. 6° W., 235 lks. dist., with a down oak alongside, 24 ins. diam., with fragmentary scribe marks visible on opened and burned blaze. (Record, S. 5° W.)

A fir, 12 ins. diam., bears S. 24½° W., 75 lks. dist., with healed double blaze.

and a bearing tree mkd. by Byron, in 1969

A fir, 7 ins. diam., bears N. 41° W., 32 lks. dist., with scribe marks NE DLC #39 CS BT visible on open double blaze.

Corner is located in head of ravine, drains SW.
